Find the Joker Game
Find the Joker Rules Strictly over 18s

1. A complete deck of cards plus the Joker is added to 53 individual envelopes and sealed. Envelopes are shuffled and labelled 1-53.
2. Each envelope is placed in a notice board in numerical order with the envelope numbers facing outwards. This notice board is locked and only opened at the draw. The notice board has a Glass Door so all numbered envelopes are visible.
3. To enter the draw place €2 in an envelope which will be provided by the Joker Team with your name, contact number and your selected number where you think the Joker resides. Place the envelope in the Joker box for the weekly draw.
4. You can only choose one number per envelope but you can enter as many €2 envelopes as you want and as many different numbers as you want.
5. The draw will take place most Sunday (except bank holidays when draw will take place on the bank holiday Monday) in Forrest Little Golf Club. Winter draw will be every 2 weeks. The drum containing the envelopes will be rotated and a single envelope will be selected blindly.
6. The name of the person and the number that was selected will be announced. The numbered enveloped will be taken from the notice board and the card exposed.
7. If the number is not the joker then that person will receive the weekly prize. If the person is present at the draw, they will receive a bonus €20 added to their loyalty card. If they are not a member they will receive a voucher for use at the bar.
8. The exposed card will now be placed facing outwards in the notice board and the game will continue for another week and so forth until the Joker is found. As the number of exposed cards become greater finding the Joker becomes more interesting
9. WHEN the Joker is found then that person will get the Joker Money in full whether they are at the draw or not.
10. The joker will start at €400 and will increase each week as the game progresses. The more people that play the greater the joker prize. The Joker jackpot and weekly prize will be announced each week prior to the start of the draw and the game will continue until the joker is found.
11. If a person picks a number by mistake that has previously been selected then that person's card will automatically be assigned to the lowest unopened numbered envelope.
12. The social committee reserve the right to increase or decrease weekly pay-out depending on the number of entries.
